MONTANA PRO RODEO HALL AND WALL OF FAME SCHOLARSHIPS

PRIORITIES:

The following is a list of priorities the MPRHWF takes into consideration when selecting scholarship winners. Please keep these points in mind when completing the attached application and during the interview process.

1. Applicant must have a financial need to attend college.
2. Applicant must continue a rodeo career during college.
3. Applicant must possess the character to serve their community.
4. Applicant must possess the desire and ability to perpetuate the gift.

REQUIREMENTS:

The following is a list of requirements scholarship applicants must meet in order to be considered for the scholarship award.

1. The applicant must be a current member of MHSRA and in good standing.
2. The applicant must be a graduating senior in the current school year.
3. The applicant must plan on attending an accredited university or trade school the immediate fall semester after high school graduation.
4. The applicant must personally attend a scholarship interview at the MHSRA State Finals.

Once the scholarship recipients are chosen, these recipients must meet the following requirements in order to receive the scholarship award.

1. The recipient must show proof of registration to an accredited university or trade school for each semester the scholarship is to be dispersed.
2. The recipient must show proof of passing grades for each semester the scholarship is to be dispersed.
3. The recipient must be able to prove their rodeo career is continuing during college through participation in a rodeo association (provide copy of membership card).

SCHOLARSHIP DISPURSEMENT:

1. It is the interest of the Montana Pro Rodeo Hall and Wall of Fame along with the agreement of the MHSRA Board of Directors to distribute scholarship awards over a four semester period beginning fall semester of the recipient's freshman year continuing through spring semester sophomore year.
2. The scholarship award check will be written to the recipient and his/her respective college/university.
